RECIPIE CORNER



🍉 BRINJAL MASALA 🔪

6-8 small brinjals

1/4 cup oil

1/2 cup onions finely chopped

- 1/2 tsp each garlic paste and ginger paste
- 1/4 cup grated dry coconut
- 1 tbsp coriander seeds-roasted light brown

2 tsp each, cumin, sesame seeds-roasted separately until light brown

- 2 tsp tamarind paste or to taste
- 1/4 tsp turmeric
- 1/2 tsp chilly powder
- 7-8 curry leaves
- 1 tbsp coriander for garnish

*Slit the brinjals and deep fry over high heat, until tender. Remove from oil and keep aside. Grind the coconut and the roasted coriander, cumin and sesame see Heat ¼ cup of oil, sauté the onions, ginger & garlic until they are a bit transparent. Add curry leaves and stir. Add the grounded mixture and sauté until oil separates. Add the tamarind paste, salt, turmeric, red pepper and mix well, then add brinjals and stir, add another ¼ cup of water, bring to boil and simmer, covered for about 5 minutes. Then it is ready for serving.
