The 40th Annual General meeting of IASAP (Tamilnadu Chapter) was held on 19th August 2023 at Hotel Shilton Dee Cee Manor, T. Nagar, Chennai attended by 25 members.

Chairperson Priya Balaji welcomed the members and proceeded with the agenda items.

The minutes of the last AGM were approved. The Secretary's Report for the year 2022-23 was also approved.

The accounts were then considered. There were a few questions raised regarding funds in the savings bank, when we can fetch more interest if it is placed in fixed deposit. It was clarified that the chapters need to send money to the charity commissioner in Mumbai. Once this is done, there will be clarity on the balance amount available. Members suggested that the amount may be placed in 2/3 short-term FDs. It was also mentioned that a sum of Rs. 8 lakhs was paid as GST on registration fee for the convention and the entire pan India members benefited.

Re-appointment of auditors, the same auditors will continue for another year. However, enquiries will be made to get some other auditors as this auditor has been delaying finalizing the accounts.

The election of office bearers was done by Mr. Jagadeesan, the returning Officer, and he announced the names of office bearers.

The proceedings were witnessed by Kashmira and Vijayalakshmi through video from Mumbai Headquarters.

We were informed about Kolkata convention in August 2024. Members desired to have a Pre or Post trip, visiting places like Darjeeling, Gangtok, etc.
